General Information	
Insurance	<p>Students should hold following insurances during their stay at the University of Lucerne:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Overseas health insurance In Switzerland, private health insurance is compulsory. Please check with your insurer in due time whether the coverage for sickness and accident is valid during the stay in Switzerland. Please send us a copy of your insurance policy together with your application forms. If the health insurance cover proves to be insufficient for Switzerland, exchange students will have to take out an insurance policy in Switzerland. ▪ Overseas liability Insurance Personal liability insurance is not compulsory in Switzerland but it is however strongly recommended (e.g. in case of renting an apartment or room). Personal liability insurance offers an insurance cover in case of third party liability claims. Exchange students have should check with their own insurer, whether the insurance coverage is sufficient for Switzerland. For exchange students who stay at an university dormitory, personal liability insurance is mandatory. If the liability insurance cover proves to be insufficient for Switzerland, exchange students will have to take out an insurance policy in Switzerland.
Entering – Registration	<p>After entering Switzerland, all students are required to register at the registration office of their community of residence.</p>
Costs for the Communal Registration and Registration at the Immigration Office	<p>The registration (approx. EUR 30-50) and all officially issued documents (approx. EUR 50-250) are chargeable. The University of Lucerne assumes no cost.</p>
Scholarships available to Exchange Students	<p>If you visit the University of Lucerne on the basis of the ERASMUS program, you are not entitled to a scholarship from the University of Lucerne. For a scholarship of ERASMUS please ask your home university.</p>
