Can exchange students attend your university for just 1 semester?	Yes, they can.
Services available for Exchange students (Airport Reception, Orientation, etc...)	An orientation week, help from French students to choose courses, a visit of Rennes, helpful information meetings (for example, how to open a bank account), and meetings with teachers.
Is University accommodation available for Exchange students?	Yes it is. Students coming from a non European country also need a surety
How & when should students apply for housing?	They should fill the Accomodation Application form together with the other documents, and send it before the deadline The number of room is limited
What is the cost for housing? (please specify if necessary per week / month / semester)	It costs about 140€ per month
Average living costs per month (food, transportation, etc.)	It depends. A food in a Restaurant Universitaire costs about 3.00€ A room in a residence hall costs about 140€
Are Exchange students required to obtain your University medical insurance or do they need to bring insurance with them from France?	European students only need the European Insurance Card. Students coming from a non-european country need to pay another insurance when arriving here (about 200€)
